

To prioritize the safety of passengers and crew and to ensure a safe voyage, the following items (hereinafter referred to as “Prohibited Items”) are not permitted on board. These items will be confiscated and may not be brought onto the ship. Any items deemed illegal will be reported to the appropriate authorities.

List of Prohibited Items

- Narcotics/prohibited drugs (including marijuana prescribed for medical purposes and any other accessories associated with drug use; this also applies to hookahs)
- All firearms, including replicas, imitations, deactivated firearms, starter pistols, and their components
- BB or pellet guns
- Other projectile weapons or objects resembling or comparable to a firearm (e.g., paintball guns)
- All types of ammunition or replicas intended for the items in sections 2, 3, and 4 above
- All types of explosives and components (e.g., detonators), including replicas of explosives or devices
- Fireworks, flares, and pyrotechnic products
- Martial arts weapons (e.g., shuriken throwing stars, nunchaku)
- Knives with a blade longer than 3 cm (1.2 inches)
- Straight razors
- Sabers, Sgian Dubh, or kirpans
- Harpoons or spear guns
- Crossbows, crossbow bolts, and arrows
- Blunt weapons such as brass knuckles, maces, telescopic batons, clubs, flails, or nunchaku
- Items containing incapacitating substances (e.g., gas pistols, tear gas spray, tear gas, phosphorus, acid, and other potentially harmful or disabling chemicals)
- Restraining devices (e.g., handcuffs, leg or head restraints)
- Flammable substances or hazardous chemicals (e.g., gasoline, denatured alcohol, paint thinner, lighter fluid, etc.)
- Any other object manufactured, modified, or used as an offensive weapon
- Stunning devices (Tasers and stun guns)
- Large batteries with a capacity greater than 100Wh (e.g., spare or external backup batteries). On board, passengers are also advised to avoid charging their battery-powered devices overnight.
- Items brought on board that are not supplied by the company and contain any heating element (e.g., immersion heaters, electric blankets, irons, kettles, coffee machines with hot plates, rice cookers, etc.)
- Any flying object, toy, or drone, whether autonomous or remotely controlled
- Hoverboards, scooters, electric scooters, or Segways
- Compressed air bottles/tanks, cylinders including scuba tanks, propane bottles, and large aerosol cans
- Emergency Position Indicating Radio Beacons (EPIRBs), amateur radios, satellite phones, transformers, lasers, and laser pointers

- Any type of radio or phone jamming equipment
- Samsung Note 7 devices
- Candles

Goods or objects whose contents could threaten the health and safety of other passengers or their luggage, people and property, or could damage or pollute the ship—including flammable, explosive, corrosive, dangerous, odorous, or leaking materials, as well as items whose importation is prohibited or which do not comply with customs or police regulations, and in general, goods and objects other than those intended for the personal use of the passenger—are prohibited on board and in luggage.

The passenger shall, in all cases, be liable for any injury, loss, or damage resulting from the presence of Prohibited Items in their luggage or cabin and must indemnify the Cruise Organizer (HANKYU TRAVEL INTERNATIONAL), the Carrier, and/or Compagnie du Ponant against any actions that may be brought against them due to the presence of such Prohibited Items on board, during embarkation, or disembarkation. These Prohibited Items may, at any time and in any place, be disembarked, destroyed, thrown overboard, or rendered harmless by the Cruise Organizer (HANKYU TRAVEL INTERNATIONAL), the Carrier, the crew, and/or Compagnie du Ponant, without compensation and notwithstanding the passenger's payment of any destruction costs.
